# PRO-LEARN

Fostering children's learning process & cognitive abilities through holistic approach & innovative methods

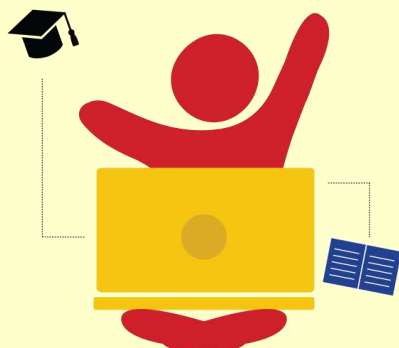
### The project aims to:

- reduce early school dropout through speed up the learning process
- overcome shortage of specialists at schools (psychologist, pedagogues)
- improve engagement of parents in learning processes of their children and development of their cognitive abilities
- offer free-of-charge and barrier-free tools (including the ICT-based ones), for diagnosis of cognitive processes and the preferred learning style of children aged 6-14 years old
- offer free-of-charge training programs and educational-oriented materials for parents, educators to support pupils in the development of effective learning skills



### The four main intellectual outputs are:

- Output 1 - Electronic tool for diagnosis of cognitive processes and learning styles of younger children (6-10 years old)
- Output 2 - Electronic tool for diagnosis of cognitive processes and learning styles for older children (11-14 years old)
- Output 3 - Training toolkit for teachers and educators
- Output 4 - Educational toolkit for students



## Project's last online meeting

During the last online meeting, conducted on July 27th, partners discussed about the finalization of the electronic tools (the PRO-LEARN Kids and PRO-LEARN Teens tools) and the training tools for students and teachers. The last tasks for the project's closure were also set.



# Multiplier Events

All partners organized multiplier events for the dissemination of the electronic tools, the training platform, and the toolkit, which were developed by a group of experts from the countries of the consortium.

More than 250 people participated in the multiplier events. Among the participants, there were educators and teachers from primary and secondary education, school leaders, ministry representatives (e.g., inspectors), psychologists, teachers of special needs students, representatives of parents' boards (from both primary and secondary education), the presidents of the community's school board and the mayors (in some of the countries).

During the multiplier events, the participants had the opportunity to engage in various activities to learn the content of the project deliverables and understand their value in education. They also provided us valuable feedback about the deliverables and positive comments about the work done from the partners during the Pro-Learn project.
